The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS William V. Johnson of St. Clair County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa in Alabama whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William V. Johnson according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the north west quarter of Section twenty of Township twenty in Range two East in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama containing One hundred and sixty acres and seventy one hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said William V. Johnson

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said William V. Johnson and his heirs the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said William V. Johnson and his heirs and assigns forever.

This patent is granted as and for a patent intended to have been granted and issued on October 20, 1824, but the issuance of which is not sufficiently evidenced by the records of the Bureau of Land Management.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the undersigned authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of June 17, 1948 (62 Stat. 476), has, in the name of the United States, caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the Bureau to be hereunto affixed.
