Before me, L. E. Parker, a Notary Public in and for the State of Alabama at Large, personally appeared George Vick , who is known to me and after first being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is George Vick . I am 65 years of age and reside in Shelby County, Alabama. I have been familiar with the hereinabove described land and have known its possessor for more than 30 years. This land is best described as:

Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter (SWa of NWa), Section 32, Township 20 South, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama.

I know that in about 1936, the above described land was in the possession of Paul O. Luck and R. Brewer who claimed joint ownership thereof. In about 1948, the said R. Brewer and his wife Lena Brewer conveyed their one-half undivided interest in this land to the said Paul O. Luck who took immediate possession of all of this land claiming sole ownership and continued in this position until his death in about 1960. Thereafter his widow, Clarice White Luck, sole legatee under the Will of the said Paul O. Luck, continued in possession of this land jointly with Ruth Luck Gordon, her daughter, and later in about 1960 conveyed to her by deed a one-half undivided interest in this land and have continued in this position up until the present time.

I know that in about 1949 the said R. Brewer and his wife executed a mortgage to Paul O. Luck covering certain lands in Shelby County that the Brewers owned jointly with Paul O. Luck. In the mortgage, captioned lands were inadvertently included as the Brewers did not own any interest in captioned lands in 1949.
