Whereas Joseph Hooper of Shelby County

has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Sacramento whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Joseph Hooper according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 25th of April, 1830, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the East half of the North East quarter of Section thirty five, in Township twenty one of Range one West, in the District of lands subject to sale at Sacramento, California, containing eighty one acres and fourteen hundredths of an acre (Section twenty) according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Survey General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Joseph Hooper

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said

Joseph Hooper

and to his heirs, being the said tract above described:

That have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature, thenceunto belonging unto the said Joseph Hooper and to his heirs and assigns forever.
