CERTIFICATE

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting: WHEREAS *Simon Butler of Shelby County, Alabama,*

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE of *Decatur, Ga.*, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

*Simon Butler,* according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 21st of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the public half of the North east fractional quarter of Section *Twenty*, in Township *Twenty* N., of Range *West*, in the District of Lands subject to sale as *Decatur, Alabama*, containing *Twenty* acre, and *Eighty four hundredths* of an acre,

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said *lands*, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Simon Butler,*

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said *Simon Butler,*

and to his heirs the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Simon Butler,* and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *Franklin Pierce* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
