

When I first remember said land it was owned by J. F. Pope. I recall where the old Pope house was about the center of the above described property and they had a servant house and other outbuildings and the east line adjoined and lay along the west line of the Amos Daniel lot, then owned by Stewart and now owned by affiant. It is affiant's understanding said property also includes a small strip of land lying north of Columbiana-Wilsonville Highway and south of Blue Springs road.



Affiant further says that throughout all the years he has known said property, he has never heard of anyone contesting the title or disputing the possession of Juanita T. Williams or her predecessors in title.
