the first part does hereby remise, release, and forever quit claim

all the right, title, and interest of the party of the first part,  
in and to the following described lands, situated in Shelby County,  
Alabama, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southwest  
Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 9, Town-  
ship 24, Range 13 East, and run thence East along the  
North line of said forty acres for a distance of 143  
yards to the point of beginning of the tract of land  
herein described and conveyed: From said point of begin-  
ning run thence South 440 yards, more or less, to the  
South line of said forty acres; run thence East along  
the South line of said forty acres for a distance of  
169 yards; run thence North 70 yards; run thence West  
70 yards; run thence North 300 yards; run thence West  
70 yards; run thence North 70 yards to the North line

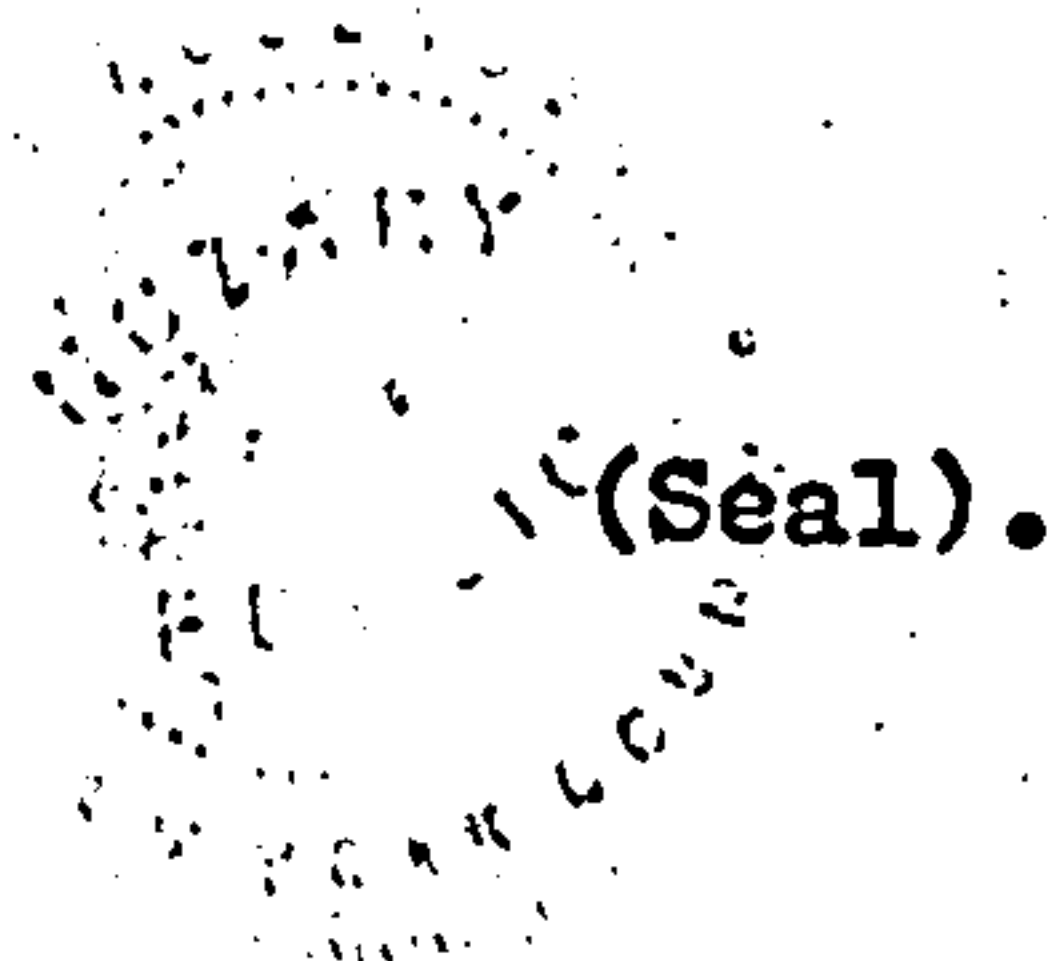

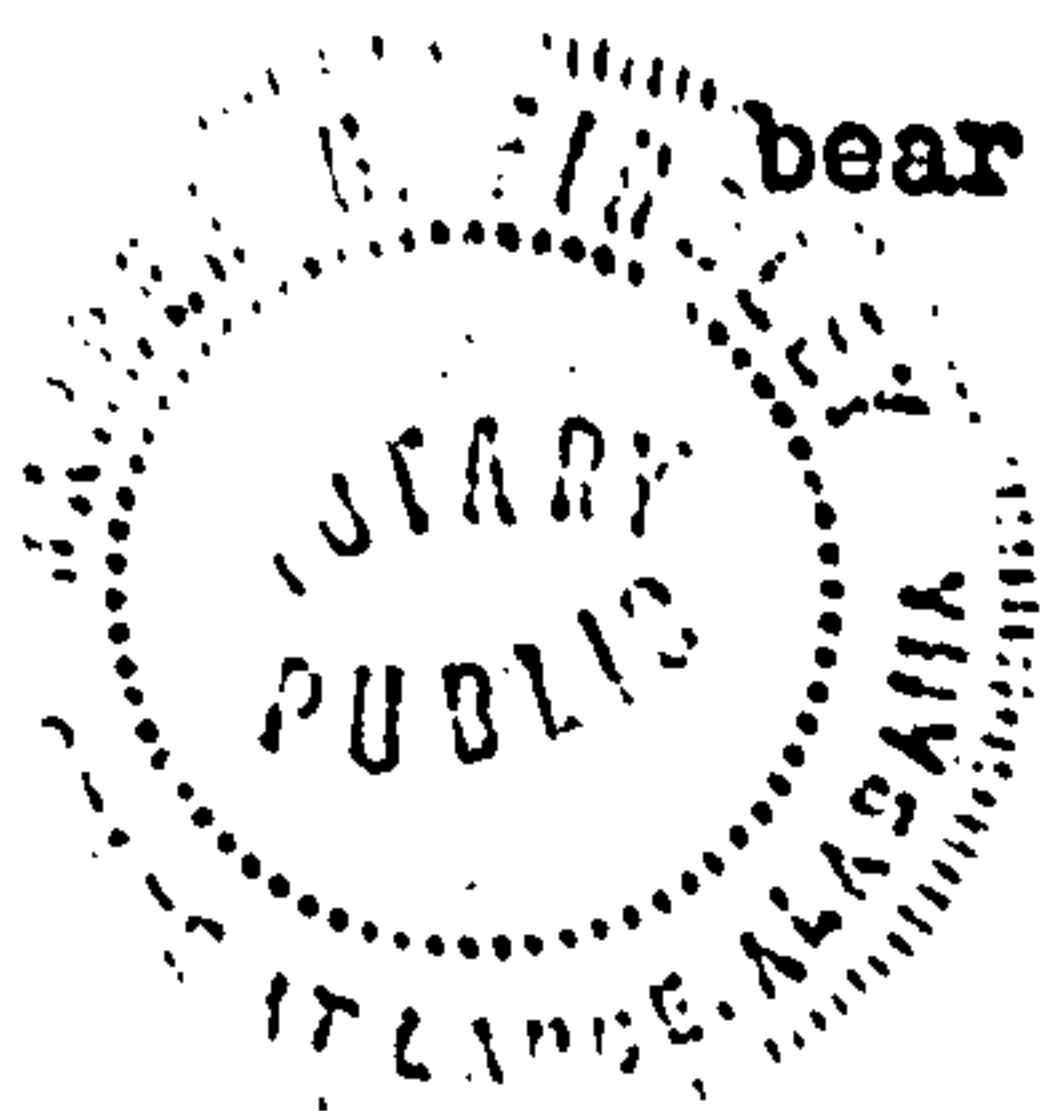
