Before me, the undersigned authority, a Notary Public in and for the State of Alabama at Large, personally appeared T. A. Weldon, who is known to me and, who, being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

I am 69 years of age and reside in Shelby County, Alabama. I have personal knowledge of the Bethlehem Baptist Church and the land upon which it is situated. The said Church property is described as follows:

A parcel of land in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 1, Township 24 North, Range 15 East and in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 2, Township 24 North, Range 15 East, Shelby County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 2, Township 24 North, Range 15 East; thence West along the South line of said quarter-quarter section 276.5 feet more or less to the Richmond Merrell property; thence North along the East line of said Richmond Merrell property 626.1 feet more or less to the property owned by Anita May and others; thence East along the South line of the property of Anita May and others 276.5 feet to the East line of said quarter-quarter section; thence continue in the same direction 180 feet; thence South 626.1 feet to the South line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 1, Township 24 North, Range 15 East; thence West 180 feet to the point of beginning, together with the right of ingress and egress thereto.

The Bethlehem Baptist Church has been in existence and has held regular services during all my life time. It is by reputation in the community the second oldest church in Shelby County, Alabama. There is a plaque in the Church giving the date of its establishment which is approximately 130 years ago. The adjacent cemetery is the property of the Church and has been used by members of this church as a burial place throughout the existence of the Church.

This affidavit is given for the purpose of particularly describing the Bethlehem Baptist Church property referred to in that certain affidavit given by me on the 20th day of September 1966 and recorded in Deed Book 245 at page 161 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.
