I, the undersigned, BROWN GEORGE, (also known as B. GEORGE), a resident of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, hereby expressly revoking any and all Wills heretofore made by me.

ITEM ONE:

I will and direct that all my just debts, including the debts of my last illness and funeral expenses, be paid by my Executrices hereinafter named, as soon after my death as the condition of my estate makes practical.

ITEM TWO:

I hereby will, devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, KATHERINE JEANETTE GEORGE, (also known as K. J. GEORGE), all of my estate, real, personal, or mixed, or of whatsoever kind or nature, should she survive me, and, should she predecease me, then it is my wish and desire that my estate be divided equally among my children; namely, CHRISTINE GEORGE OZBURN, JEANETTE GEORGE LANEY, GENEVA GEORGE JARDET and DOROTHY GEORGE WELCH, all of Birmingham, Alabama, and ALBERTA GEORGE CROWDER and MARIE GEORGE BARRANCO of St. Petersburg, Florida, and CHARLES DAVID GEORGE of Columbia, Tennessee, but to be paid in the following manner:

CHRISTINE GEORGE OZBURN, JEANETTE GEORGE LANEY and GENEVA GEORGE JARDET shall be paid their full share upon the death of their mother, and the remaining children's shares shall be set aside to them, and in the discretion of my Executrices, these shares to be paid in monthly, semi-annual or annual installments and in amounts that my Executrices deem favorable, leaving the matter of payment entirely to the discretion and judgment of my Executrices hereinafter named. Should any of the children predecease their mother, then the share going to any one of the children shall be divided equally among the child

All bonds of every nature or character that are now, or hereafter will be required, being hereby expressly waived, to the end that the beneficiaries hereunder shall immediately enjoy the full fruits and benefits of my estate immediately upon my death, free from the claims of any courts or any persons whatsoever.

I hereby authorize and empower my said Executrices, CHRISTINE GEORGE OZBURN and MARIE GEORGE BARRANCO, to sell at public or private sale, and without order of court, and by proper instrument convey any or all property at any time belonging to my estate, before the final settlement of said administration, at such time, prices, or upon such terms as they may see fit, if and when they may deem such sale necessary or proper for the interest of my estate.
