KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That in consideration of One dollar and other good and valuable considerations DOLLARS

to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we,

Columbus G. Gill and wife, Gordalee Gill

(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto

Garry Wayne Gill and wife, Mervin Ann Gill

(herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated

in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

From the Southeast corner of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 19, Township 18 South, Range 2 East run North along the East boundary line of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4, Sec. 19, T. 18s. R. 2E. for 630.89 feet, more or less, to a point on the Southwest Right of Way line of the Central of Georgia R.R.; thence turn an angle of 44 Degrees, 05 Minutes to the left and run Northwesterly along the Southwest R.O.W. line of the Central of Georgia R. R. for 396.07 feet; thence turn an angle of 90 Degrees, 00 Minutes to the left and run Southwesterly 210.0 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein described; Thence turn an angle of 109 Degrees, 39 Minutes to the right and run Northwesterly 100.0 feet; Thence turn an angle of 109 Degrees, 39 Minutes to the left and run Southwesterly 150.0 feet, more or less, to a point on the East Right of Way line of a County Road; thence turn an angle of 70 Degrees, 21 Minutes to the left and run Southwesterly along the East R.O.W. line of the County Road for 100.0 feet; Thence turn an angle of 109 Degrees, 39 Minutes to the left and run Northeasterly for 150.0 feet to the point of beginning. This being a part of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 19, Township 18 South, Range 2 East, and being 0.344 acres, more or less.
