The Lessor reserves all timber rights on said tract of land to be cut and removed on a selective cutting basis if and when it sees that any timber needs cutting for the betterment of the property.

This lease takes the place of any and all leases in any form that have been previously made between the Lessor and Lessee.

It is further understood that any time the Lessee desires to change the name of the Came Preserve or change the constitution and by-laws of said organization, said changes shall first be presented to the Lessor for its approval.
