

My name is James L. Ray, Jr. and I am a resident of Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama. I have served as County Engineer for Shelby County, Alabama, since 1956, and until the present date. Part of my duties in such position are supervising construction and maintenance of county roads within Shelby County, Alabama.

It has been called to my attention that Deed Book 135, page 363, Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, contains the record of a right of way deed to Shelby County dated September 7, 1950, designating certain right of way which was conveyed to Shelby County for Shelby County Project SACP 464, and that said right of way deed designates the right of way conveyed as being situated in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 20, Range 3 West.

Said Project SACP 464 was a Shelby County project for paving a road from Pelham to Helena to Acton in Shelby County, Alabama. No part of said road or said project runs through or within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 20, Range 3 West, or within at least a quarter of a mile thereof, and it is evident that the description contained in said right of way deed recorded in said Daed Book 135 at page 363 is in error.
