DECREE OF SALE

This cause, this day, coming on to be heard on bill of complaint, answer of the respondent and the evidence as noted on the note of testimony and the testimony taken orally before the Court and taken down by the official court reporter, all of said parties being present in court or represented by their attorneys of record, the Court proceeded to hear and determine said cause. The Court, having heard and considered the evidence in said cause, finds that the property described in the bill of complaint is vested in said parties as set out in the bill of complaint as follows:

end that the property is not capable of being equitably divided or partitioned in kind and that said parties are joint owners and tenants in common of said property.

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The Court further finds that Junius A. Lambert, one of the Complainants in said cause and his wife, Minnie P. Lambert, originally owned said property, purchasing the same in November of 1945; that said Minnie P. Lambert deceased on the 22nd day of September, 1966, intestate, and at the time of her death was survived by her husband, the Complainant, Junius A. Lambert, and one son, Grady Lambert; that any debts which the said Minnie P. Lambert owed have long since been paid; that Grady Lambert, the son of Minnie P. Lambert, deceased in June of 1967 intestate and was survived by his widow, Mary Lambert Lynn, and four children, Darline Lambert, Debbia Lambert, Grady Lambert, Jr., and Mary Lambert, all being minors and that any debts which the said Grady Lambert owed at the time of his death have been paid in full.

The Court further finds that Billy G. Riley and Howard L. Stephenson have offered to purchase said property at and for the sum of \$20,000.00 cash, which said sum equals to or exceeds the reasonable market value of the same and that it would be to the best interest of all parties that said property be sold to said purchasers for said sum;

The Court further finds that it is necessary to furnish an abstract of title to people in this vicinity in selling said property and that the cost of the same is a reasonable and proper charge against the sales price.

The Court further finds that Imomas R.M.ENIRY is a suitable and proper person to act as Commissioner in said cause in the sale of said property.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that

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
