



## Alabama and Tennessee Rail Road

List of lands, in the district of lands subject to sale at Fusealibba Alabama, within the six mile limits, granted to the State of Alabama, by the act of Congress approved the 3d of June 1856, entitled "an act granting public lands in alternate sections to the State of Alabama to aid in the construction of certain Rail Roads in said State." Being the placent and unappropriated lands in the alternate sections designated as odd numbers for six sections in width on each side of the Rail Road from Selma to Gadsden in said State."

do hereby certify that the foregoing on pages 1 to 5  
 inclusive, is a true and correct list of the tracts of land **WITHIN THE SIX-MILE LIMITS** granted to  
 the State of Alabama, by the act of Congress approved 3d June 1856  
 entitled "An act granting public lands in alternate sections  
 to the State of Alabama to aid in the construction of certain  
 Rail Roads in said state", and within the district of lands  
 subject to sale at Huntsville Alabama,  
 being the vacant and unappropriated lands in the alternate sections designated by odd  
 numbers, FOR SIX SECTIONS IN WIDTH ON EACH SIDE of the Rail Road from Selma  
to Jackson in said state and known as the Alabama  
 and Tennessee Rail Road,

within the State of Alabama, and they are now submitted for the  
 approval of the Secretary of the Interior, in accordance with the requirements of said  
 act of 3d June 1856, subject to all its conditions, and to any valid interfering  
 rights which may exist to any of the tracts embraced in the foregoing list.
