DECREE

This cause now coming on to be heard is submitted for a final decree upon the petition, notices and affidavits as shown by a note of submission; and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion and finds that all the allegations of the petition are true; that the said William Glenn Smith is a minor over the age of eighteen years and under the age of twenty-one years; that he is a resident of Shelby County and is for his age a person of mature judgment, of sober and industrious habits, and is competent and capable in every way of handling his own affairs, and is the owner of property in Shelby County, Alabama; that said minor has no legal guardian, and that said petition is properly brought by the father of said minor, who is a resident of Shelby County, Alabama; that said minor was born on August 24, 1949; the Court further finds that it is to the best interest of such minor to grant the prayer of his petition, it is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED by the Court:

1. That the said William Glenn Smith be and he is hereby relieved from the disabilities of non-age and is now invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and in general to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age.

2. That the said William Glenn Smith file a certified copy of this decree in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and in each of the counties in which said minor shall hereafter reside, and in the Office of the Judge of Probate in each county in the State where said minor shall do any business

or make any contracts.

3. That the Petitioner pay the costs of these proceedings to be taxed by the Register for which execution may issue.
