Before me, a Notary Public in and for said County and State, personally appeared Fred Yarbrough, who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Fred Yarbrough. I am 78 years of age and reside at Box 61, Calera, Shelby County, Alabama.

I have been familiar with the ownership and possession of the East Half of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 22, S., ^{Range} 2 West for the past 30 or more years, having been the owner of said property since August, 1937, and having actually lived and resided on said property continuously ^{since} prior to 1940.

As stated, I bought said property from Henry Riney in August, 1937, receiving a warranty deed and immediately taking possession of said property under said warranty deed. There was no house on said property nor was it fenced, nor was any part of it in cultivation in 1937, but within a couple of years and before 1940, my wife and I built a house on said property and fenced the ^{entire eighty} acres. The old original wire fence is still visible.

I cleaned up and cleared twenty to twenty-five acres of said property about the time I bought it and have had crops ^{cleared} on said/portion from year to year until three or four years ago, and I have harvested hay from the cleared portion since then.

Interstate Highway I-65 crosses said property, and I still own all of said property, subject to right of way for said Interstate Highway and except a lot which my wife and I conveyed Mosley Chapel Baptist Church as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 116 at page 462, Office of Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama, and except a lot which my wife and I conveyed to Angela Cunningham and husband, Earl Cunningham, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 193 at page 281 in said Probate Office.


About eight or ten years ago, my wife and I bought a house and moved it on the portion of said property which lies to the west of said I-65 Highway. We rented this house for several years,

and when it burned five or six years ago, we built another house on said property, which has been rented since then from time to time .

Said property is also served by a County Road passing through a portion thereof.

I do not know, nor have I ever known, Joe Hull nor Joseph Hull, whom I understand were one and the same person and who are shown by my abstract to have been a former owner of said property, nor Monroe Carlton, nor Emma Gilmore. I do know that none of said persons have lived in the vicinity of said property, nor have any of said persons claimed, occupied, or possessed any part of said property nor have I heard of said persons at all, since 1937 when I became the owner of said property.

No one other than said Henry Riney and his successors in title, being myself and those to whom I have conveyed, as designated above, have possessed said property, nor any part thereof since 1937 until the present date, said Henry Riney and his said successors in title having been in the actual, open, continuous, notorious, undisturbed, peaceable, exclusive, hostile adverse possession of all said property since 1937 and until the present date.
