a right of way and easement to construct, operate, maintain, replace and remove  
such communication systems as the grantees may from time to time require, consisting  
of underground cables, wires, conduits, manholes, drains and splicing boxes, and  
surface testing-terminals, repeaters, repeater housings and markers, and other  
appurtenances, upon, over and under a strip of land 10 feet wide across  
the land which the undersigned own(s) or in which the undersigned (has)(have) any  
interest in SEC 36 T-24N R-11E.

County of BIBB, and State of Alabama, together with the following rights:  
of ingress and egress over and across the lands of the undersigned to and from said  
strip for the purpose of exercising the rights herein granted; to place surface  
markers beyond said strip; to clear and keep cleared all trees, roots, brush, and  
other obstructions from the surface and subsurface of said strip. The boundaries of  
said strip shall be lines parallel to and 5 feet each side of the first cable  
laid, which cable shall have its location indicated upon surface markers set at  
intervals on the land of the undersigned or on adjacent lands.


