THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into on this 2nd day of August, 1968, by and between KIMBERLY-CLARK CORPORATION, a corporation, party of the first part, and MAYLENE CHURCH OF GOD, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of Two Hundred Twenty-six Dollars (\$226.00) to the party of the first part in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part has granted, bargained and sold, and does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part the following described real property, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to wit:

Commence at the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter (NW¹/₄ of NW¹/₄) of Section 21, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama, thence south 57 degrees 30 minutes west for a distance of 178 feet to the point of beginning, thence south 57 degrees 30 minutes west for a distance of 448.8 feet, thence north 12 degrees east for a distance of 240 feet, thence north 46 degrees east for a distance of 384 feet, thence along the highway right of way for a distance of 291 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.26 acres, more or less.

Such land is conveyed subject to that certain Indenture of Mortgage and Deed of Trust, dated as of January 1, 1948, from Coosa River Newsprint Company to the Chase National Bank of the City of New York, as Trustee, recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, in Mortgage Record Book 205, at page 1; subject to the Supplemental Indenture of Mortgage, executed between the same parties and recorded in the same office in Mortgage Record Book 242, at page 101; subject to Third Supplemental Indenture, dated May 31, 1962, executed by Kimberly-Clark Corporation to The Chase Manhattan Bank and First National City Bank, and recorded in the same office in Mortgage Record Book 277, at page 680, and subject to any existing easements for public roads, utilities lines, and ad valorem tax liens for the current tax year.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, together with all and singular the rights, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, unto the party of the second part, its heirs and assigns, forever.

And the party of the first part does hereby covenant with the party of the second part that it is lawfully seized in fee of the said premises, that it has a good right to sell and convey the same; that said premises are free from encumbrances except as stated herein; and that it warrants, and will forever defend the title to said premises against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

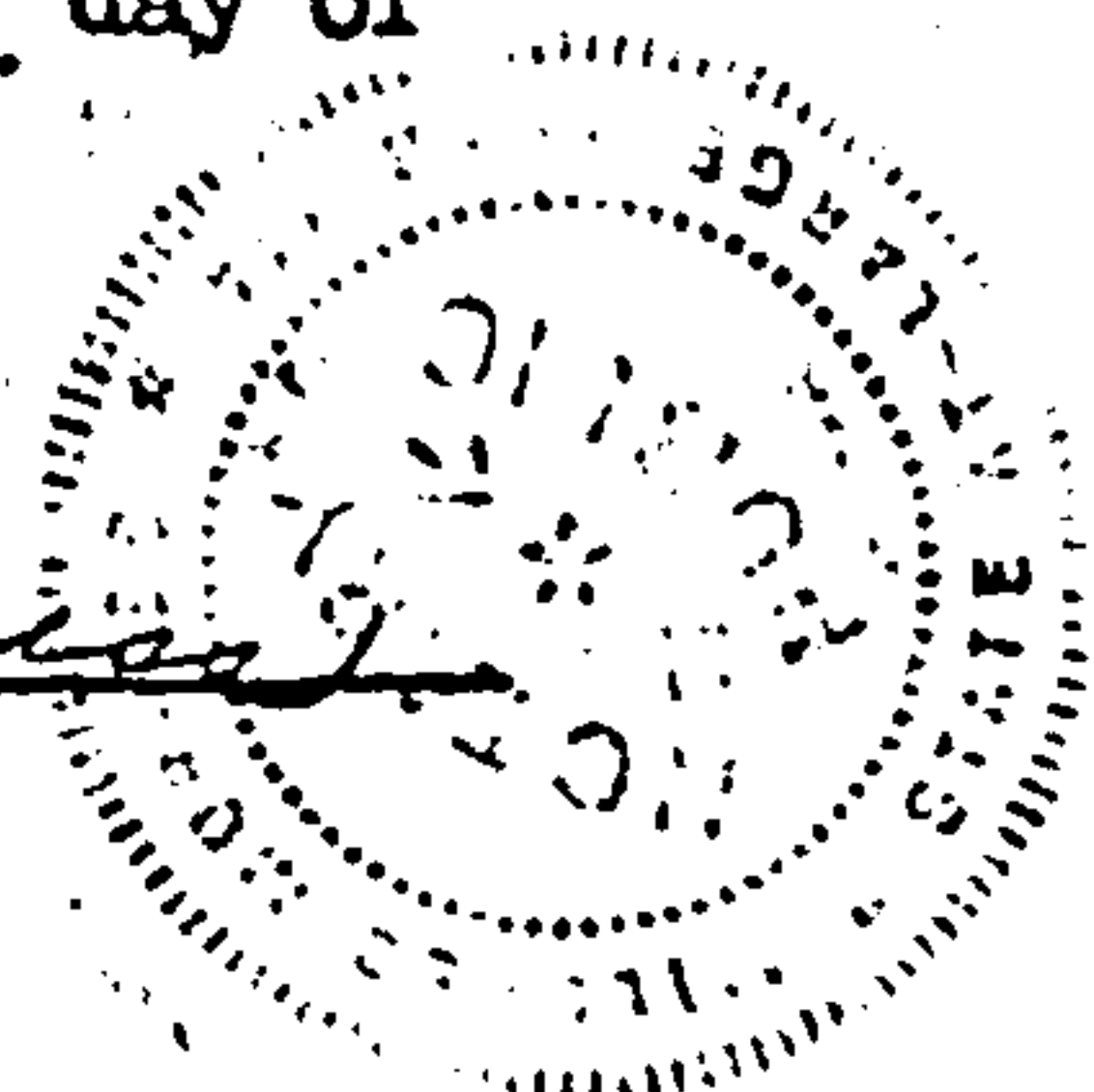
