That part of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 30, Township 19 South, Range 2 East which lies East of U. S. Highway 280 and North of the center line of the charted road to Howard Payton's Lake, being 6 acres, more or less. Said road being more particularly described in that certain right of way deed recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Deed Book 234, page 48 dated December 23, 1964.

Grantors herein convey to grantee a right of way along, across and over that portion of said road which lies upon the property of grantor.

Subject to rights granted to other parties in easement recorded in said Probate Office in Deed Book 234, page 48.
