It is my will that this instrument bind afterborn and after adopted children.

One: I will that my executrix hereinafter named pay all of my just debts as soon as practicable after my death.

Two: BEQUEST OF ENTIRE ESTATE: I hereby give, devise, and bequeath my entire estate, real, personal, and mixed, of which I die seized or possessed to my beloved wife, Vida H. Parker, to have and to hold absolutely and forever.

In the event of a common disaster in which both I and my wife are killed:

I hereby give, devise and bequeath to Perry Ann Parker Cakes the sum of One and no/100 Dollars (\$1.00)

All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate real, personal, and mixed I hereby give devise and bequeath to Donald G. Golden and Billie L. Pierce to have and to hold as their own forever.

Three I hereby nominate and appoint my wife as executrix of this my last will and testament. It is my will that she not post bond nor account to any court for her actions as such. In the event of a common disaster I nominate and appoint Donald G. Golden under the same condition.
