

I, Pearl Wald Marcuse, a citizen of Birmingham, Alabama, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, not acting under restraint, fraud, duress or undue influence of any person whatsoever, do make, publish and declare this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other wills and codicils by me made.

First: I hereby direct my executor herein named to pay all my just debts and funeral expenses as soon after my demise as can be lawfully and conveniently done.

Second: I hereby give, devise and bequeath all of my estate, real, personal and mixed, of every kind, nature and description, wheresoever situated and howsoever held, which is or may be subject to my testamentary disposition at the time of my death unto my beloved Mother, Rosa Phillips Wald, and Sisters, Edna Jeannette Wald and Mildred Lorena Wald, to be equally divided, and share and share alike. In the event of the death of any of the foregoing heirs the estate is to be divided equally among the surviving.

Third: To any other person making a claim of any kind or description against my estate, or claiming to be an heir-at-law, or entitled to any part of my estate, I hereby give, devise and bequeath to such person, or persons, the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) each, and no more.

Fourth: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my Sister, Edna Jeannette Wald, executrix of this, my last will and testament, to serve as such executrix without bond.
