After the residence was burned William Bassham resided with afficat for approximately one month while he repaired another structure located on the above described property. Approximately one conthafter the fire he moved back into the structure situated on said property and resided there until a new residence was constructed on the above described property in 1945. Imaediately after the construction of the new residence he moved into the semo where he resided contimeously and exclusively for each and every year up until July 11, 1949, then he conveyed · all of the above described property to Paul William Adams. Immediately after the execution of the last mentioned deed on July 11, 1949, said Paul William Adams coved in & tho residence situated on the above described property and resided therein and thursen as his home for each and every year continuously and exclusively up to and including October 20, 1958, when said above described property and said residence was conveyed to James H. Hughos and Nottie Lee Hughes by deed recorded in Deed Book 196, page 213, in the Probata Records of Shelby County, Alabama. Immediately after the execution of the last contioned

Actually, in addition to residing on the above described property dath of the aforassid pradacessors in title to Nettie L. Hughes and James H. Hu hes have occupied and possessed each and every part and parcel of said land and, in fact, the entire boundaries thereof have been under fence for more than 20 years. More than 20 years are William Bassham, one of the aforesaid predecessors in title to the present camers, constructed a fence around the boundaries of the above described property for the purpose of containing horses and any other livestock which he may have owned. During the time William Bassham owned the property he not only lived in the residence situated thereon but also forced the part not in use as a residence and kept a horse and other livestock situated thereon. Affiant actually owns property which adjoins the above described property and knows that there has been no dispute whatsoever concerning the location of the boundary lines around the above described property for more than 20 years and that the present owner Nattie I.. Hughes and her predecessors in title named above, numely, James H. Hughes and Mellie Les Hughed, Paul Willian Adams, and William Bassham have been in the continuous, exclusive, notorious, adverse, and hostile possession of the above described property for each and every year during the more than 28 years I have known the occupation, use, and possession thereof. There have been no disputes conserming the ownership or possession thereof.

When the above described property was first purchased by William Bassam in the early 1940's as aforesaid, the same was unimproved and uncleared timber land. About the time he constructed the aforesaid residence on the property he cleared the same and moved the bulk of the timber therefrom.

During the more than 28 years I have known the occupation, use, and possession of the above described property it has been in the continuous, exclusive, notions, hostile and adverse possession of William Bossham. Paul William Adams, and James H. Hughes and wife, Nettie L. Hughes. No other person, firm, or corporation has been in possession of said property or any part thereof whatsoever during said period and I have never heard the title of Nettie L. Hughes and her aforested predecossors in title question or disputed in any way.
