A. WIDOW do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said ROSA M. KENDRICK

the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Ala., to-wit:

The West 14 acres of the North 24 acres of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of  
Sec. 2 T 20 Range 2 West. Also 10 acres of the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of  
SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 2 T 20 R. 2 West, described as follows:

From the Northeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 2 T 20 R. 2 West  
run due South 792 feet to the point of beginning. Continue South  
330 feet. Thence due West 1320 feet, Thence North 330 feet,  
Thence East 1320 feet to the point of beginning. Also a tract of
