There was an old fence row along the north and south sides of the land when I moved on the property and it appeared to be some 30 to 40 years old or more at that time. The trees were blazed along the east side marking the lines, which appeared to have been blazed for many years. On the west side of the land, there appeared to have been an old fence, but was barely visible when I noved there. I also observed that on the top of the hill from were I lived there was an old house place-the rocks from the chimney were crumbled down into a pile of rocks, no evidence of any wood around, but from the growth, etc, you could toll it had boon an old howseplace. The evidence shows there was an old road that led to the house and a trail leading from the houseplace some 50° to 75° from it to a apring where apparently they got water. I also know the land was known as the "old Dick Griffin place".
