Chesser and wife by the State of Alabama, for the benefit of School District No. 26, on December 8th 1913 of a two-acre lot of land in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34 Township 19 Range 1 West in Shelby County Alabama by deed which is recorded in deed book 57 page 454; that affiant lived in the vicinity of said land at that time, and he knows of his own knowledge that there was a school house built on said lot of land after said purchase, and a school was run and operated in said school house for several years until the school house was burned, which was about 6 or 7 years ago, and that since then the said lot on which said school house was built and burned that said lot has been vacant and the said State or County has never claimed any interest in the same so far as affiant knows or has learned, and has never taken possession of said lot or claimed any right of possession of same, but that said lot has been in the possession of and claim by the party who owns the balance of the said forty acres lying north of the railroad. That affiant lives in the vicinity of said land and has been living in said vicinity for the past 30 years.
