That in consideration of THREE THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED & NO/100 (\$3,800.00) DOLLARS

to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the GRANTEEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we,

Frank C. Edwards and wife, Margaret F. Edwards

(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto

Howard Edwards and wife, Ola Edwards

(herein referred to as GRANTEEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the NW side of the Montevallo Wilton Public Road 785 feet SW of the intersection of said road with the North boundary line of Section 9, Township 24 North, Range 12 East; thence run NW and perpendicular to said Public Road a distance of 464 feet, more or less to the right of way of the Southern Railway Company; thence in a Southwesterly direction along said right of way a distance of 203 feet, more or less, to the NW corner of L. L.
