My name is Armon C. Acton. I am over twenty-one (21) years of age and live in Shelby County, Alabama. On March 13, 1946, I bought the following described property from M. H. Acton and J. A. Acton:

All east of county road of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and all east of county road of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , both in Section 15, Township 19, Range 1 East, in Shelby County, Alabama.

At that time, M. H. Acton was a widower and J. A. Acton's wife was Mary R. Acton. Immediately after buying the property, I took possession of it and have occupied the same since that date. I have used this property as a farm and for dairy purposes. The entire above described property was under fence and I occupied it either as a farm, as a home, and for grazing of cattle purposes, since I have owned the lands. I have never heard anyone claiming any interest in the above described property since I bought the same in 1946. I have held and occupied the above described land adversely, openly, notoriously, continuously and peacefully since March 13, 1946.

On the 12th day of March, 1946, I bought the following described property from George Huddleston:

All west of the Sterrett County Road of the North one-half of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 15, Township 19, Range 1 East, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

At the time of the purchase, I gave Mr. Huddleston a note in the amount of \$800.00. I have paid Mr. Huddleston the \$800.00 and have receipts for the payment of the same. I have forgotten the exact date when I paid him the last payment on the mortgage, but it was many years ago.
