Blanche and Dan O'Neill died when they were only children under the age of ten years. They died without issue, intestate.

Pat O'Neill a/k/a Charles Patrick O'Neill, Sr. is deceased and is survived by only his wife, Nell Hull O'Neill and his only children: Pat O'Neill Jr., a/k/a Charles Patrick O'Neill, Jr. and Martha O'Neill Nelson, the wife of Charles Nelson. 
