EXHIBIT "A"

That certain street, avenue or alley, or portion thereof situated in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 21, Range 3 West which runs in an Easterly-Westerly direction between the Southern boundaries of Lots No. 10, and 11, and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 12 and the Northern boundary of Lots 23, 22, and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 21, according to the map of W. F. Strowd Subdivision as recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Map Book 3, page 43, which said street, avenue, alley, or portion thereof to be vacated, is more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the SE corner of said Lot No. 10 of said Subdivision for point of beginning; run thence in a Westerly direction along the Southern boundary of Lots 10, 11 and 12 of said Subdivision a distance of 125 feet to a point; thence turn to the left and run in a Southerly direction a distance of 16 feet, more or less, to a point on the Northern boundary of Lot No. 21 of said subdivision; thence turn to the left and run in an Easterly direction along the Northern boundary of said Lot No. 21, 22, and 23 of said Subdivision a distance of 125 feet to a point, which said point is the NE corner of Lot No. 23 of said Subdivision; thence turn to the left and run in a Northerly direction a distance of 16 feet more or less, to the point of beginning.
