acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Treasurer, his heirs, assigns, and assigns forever, the said tract above described, To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Treasurer, his heirs, assigns, and assigns forever.
