I, Henry N. Callahan, a resident of Route 1, Box 750, Haines City, Polk County, Florida, declare that this is my Will.

PARAGRAPH ONE: I revoke all Wills and Codicils that I have previously made.

PARAGRAPH TWO: I am married to Alyne L. Callahan and all references in this Will to "my wife" are to her. I have one child, Joan Callahan, 207 Foxhall Road, Birmingham, Alabama.

PARAGRAPH THREE: I give my real property situated in Shelby County, Alabama, and commonly known as one half interest in

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ East of
Dixie Creek; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ North of Tuscaloosa
Road less 3A of a total of 97 acres,

to my daughter, Joan Callahan.

PARAGRAPH FOUR: A. If my wife survives me for one hundred eighty (180) days, I give the residue of my estate to her.

B. If my wife does not survive me for one hundred eighty (180) days, I give the residue of my estate to my daughter, Joan Callahan.

C. If neither my wife nor my daughter, Joan Callahan survives me for one hundred eighty (180) days, I give all of my estate to those persons who would have been my heirs

PARAGRAPH FIVE: I nominate my wife, Alyne L. Callahan, Haines City, Florida, as Executor of this Will, to serve without bond. If she shall for any reason fail to qualify, or cease to act as Executor, I nominate Alyne Mathias, my step-daughter, Haines City, Florida, Executor. The term "my Executor" as used in this Will shall include any personal representative of my estate. I authorize my Executor to sell, with or without notice, at either public or private sale, and to lease any property belonging to my estate, subject only to such confirmation of court as may be required by law.

PARAGRAPH SIX: I request that my burial be simple and inexpensive.
