2. Grantee shall comply with the Shelby County and State of Alabama Health Department or other governmental regulations and policies relative to sewage, water pollution, building construction permits, noise, excessive smoke or air pollution.

3. In the event provision No. 1 above shall not be met within the one year period then the land conveyed herein will revert to Shelby County and the County shall rebate to the grantee the purchase price.

4. It is understood and agreed that grantee shall pay for any abstract, title insurance or other legal expenses of closing which grantee desires.

5. All of the above provisions shall be binding on any purchaser or assignce of grantee.

6. It is agreed and understood that Shelby County, a Body Corporate, assumes no responsibility for the installation of sanitary sewers, storm drains, gas, water, or other utility to HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said grantee, Alexander Successors and assigns forever.

And said Shelby County, Alabama, a Body Corporate does for itself, its successors and assigns, covenant with said KART, INC., its successors

and assigns, that it is lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all encumbrances, that it has a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid, and that it will, and its successors and assigns shall, warrant and defend the same to the said KART, INC., its successors
