I, Alvis A. Kendrick, a resident of St. Clair County, State of Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do make, publish and declare this instrument as and for my last will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all other wills and codicils heretofore made by me.

ITEM ONE: I give, bequeath and devise all of my property, of whatsoever kind and character and wherever situated, to my wife, Addie G. Kendrick, absolutely, if she survives me.

ITEM TWO: If my wife does not survive me, then I give, bequeath and devise all of my property, of whatsoever kind and character and wherever situated, to my descendants who survive me, whether born before or after the execution of this will, per stirpes.

ITEM THREE: If I am survived by neither my said wife nor any descendant of me, then my executor shall transfer and pay over all of my property to such persons as would be entitled to inherit said property and in the proportions in which they would be entitled to inherit the same, from me under the laws of Alabama in force at the time of my death, as if I had died a resident of Alabama intestate.

ITEM FOUR: I hereby designate and appoint my wife as executrix hereunder.

I direct that my said executrix shall not be required to give bond or to file an inventory or appraisal of my estate in any court, though she shall make out and keep an inventory and shall exhibit the same to any party in interest at any reasonable time, and I direct that she shall be free from the control and supervision of any court.

During the administration of my estate, I hereby vest in my said executrix full power to sell, convey, exchange, lease for a period beyond the termination of the administration of my estate or for less period, improve, borrow on the security of, encumber or otherwise dispose of my estate in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as my executrix may approve and to invest and reinvest my estate and the proceeds of sale or any portion thereof in such loans, bonds, stocks or other securities, mortgages, common trust funds or other property as she may consider suitable, and to change and to make new investments from time to time as to her may seem necessary or desirable, without regard to any statutory or constitutional limitation applicable to the investment of trust funds.
