




KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, Lewis B. Walker, in consideration of One thousand six hundred twenty-three and 60/100 dollars, in hand paid by First National Bank of Columbiana, do hereby transfer and assign all of my right, title and interest in and to the timber deed attached hereto from James R. Fuqua and wife, Thelma Fuqua until full amount of the indebtedness due under a mortgage being executed this date by Lewis B. Walker to said Bank for the above consideration, is paid in full.

The said Lewis B. Walker agrees to pay to the First National Bank of Columbiana, the above consideration in the following manner; Lewis B. Walker agrees to cut the timber from the land described on said Timber Deed and to pay to said Bank \$6.00 per cord of pine pulpwood cut and \$25.00 per thousand for all logs cut. In any event, the full amount of said indebtedness shown on said mortgage shall be due and payable by the 6th day of January, 1971.
