Whereas, *Edmund Henry, a citizen of John M. Harrison*, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Washington*, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *John M. Harrison*, according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the fraction of one hundred and thirty acres of land, containing two cuts in the District of Columbia, subject to sale at *Washington*, containing thirty eight acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *John M. Harrison*.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said *Edmund Henry*, and to his heirs, the said tract above described, and to his heirs, the said tract above described, whatever nature the same belonging, unto the said *Edmund Henry*, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, *Andrew Pickens*, President of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
