# The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

**Whereas** Edward Leino of the District of Columbia, County of Washington, D. C., has been appointed in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Washington, D. C., whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Edward Leino according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 28th of April, 1829, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the lot or fraction of section twenty, township twenty, range two east in the District of Columbia subject to sale at private sale, containing thirty-two acres, and twenty-five hundred and eighty-one acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Survey General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Edward Leino.

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Edward Leino, his heirs, assigns, and to his heirs and assigns forever, do have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature, hereto belonging, unto the said Edward Leino.

**IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF,** I, **William Howard Taft**, President of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
