I am 79 years of age and am one and the same person who purchased certain property from a Tax Sale held on July 7, 1930, for nonpayment of 1929 taxes, which sold in the name Harry Mancin, as shown by Tax Sale Record 10 page 263 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. The description in the Tax Sale was erroneous and when the deed was made to me, the description was corrected in it. I actually purchased the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, Township 20, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama, at said tax sale and I obtained a deed to this 80 acres and the same is recorded in Deed Book 93 page 437 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. This is the land that I took into possession under said sale. I knew Harry Mancin during his lifetime and know when he had said 80 acres in possession. He is now dead.

I have never owner or claimed any interest in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 20, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama, and I know of my own knowledge that Harry Mancin never claimed to own any portion of the same.
