The East line of the Swan property is marked by a fence bordering the West line of the Woods property and the South line is marked by a fence marking the North line of the McKibbon property, Elsie and Gertie Swan have lived in the house situated on said property when they purchased it and have kept the grass cut and kept the place clean.
