We, Charles Walter Spangler and Marie Stewart Spangler, his wife, both of the City of Birmingham, County of Jefferson, State of Alabama, do make, publish and declare this to be our joint and mutual last will and testament, hereby revoking all other and former wills by us at any time heretofore made, either jointly or severally.

First. We bequeath to our daughter, Charlotte Ann Spangler, our piano, silverware, china, jewelry, three french tables with onyx tops, an antique white bedroom suite, a living room sofa and matching chair, and an antique french walnut table which was given us by Daisy Spangler. We bequeath to the survivor of us any and all other personal property owned by either of us at the time of the death of either of us for his or her own use and benefit forever.

Second. We devise to the survivor of us any and all real property owned by either of us at the time of the death of either of us for his or her own use and benefit forever.

Third. We, Charles Walter Spangler and Marie Stewart Spangler hereby agree each with the other to abide by the joint and mutual will as herein made, and not to make any will or codicil different than this before or after the death of either one of us.

Fourth. The survivor of us is hereby appointed executor or executrix (as the case may be), and no bond shall be required of him or her as such executor or executrix.

Fifth. In the event that our deaths should occur simultaneously, or approximately so, or in the same common accident or calamity, or under any circumstances causing doubt as to which of us survived the other, then we hereby devise and bequeath our entire property to our daughter, Charlotte Ann Spangler, of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama.

Sixth. In the event that our deaths should occur simultaneously, or approximately so, or in the same common accident or calamity, or under any circumstances causing doubt as to which of us survived the other, then we hereby appoint Evelyn Stewart Tutt of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama, the executrix of this our last will and testament.
