the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section twenty eight, in Township nineteen of Range ten East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Tullesloosa, Alabama, containing forty acres and divided into a half and a quarter acre.

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Thomas M. Harper*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
