I, John Wallace Waddell, over the age of twenty-one and a resident of Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills by me made.

ITEM ONE: I direct that all of my just debts, including funeral expenses and the expenses of my last illness, be paid by my executrix hereinafter named as soon after my death as may be convenient.

ITEM TWO: I give, devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate, real, personal or mixed property of whatsoever kind and wheresoever situated, to my wife, Ruby Lois Waddell, to be hers absolutely, in fee simple, if she survive me.

ITEM THREE: In the event my wife should predecease me or should her death occur within a period of thirty days subsequent to my own I give, devise and bequeath all that property mentioned in ITEM TWO above to my daughter, Doris Waddell Hawkins, or her descendants per stirpes, absolutely.

ITEM FOUR: I hereby nominate and appoint my wife, Ruby Lois Waddell, executrix of my estate and specifically exempt her from giving bond or making any accounting or final settlement in any Court. In the event my wife predecease me or be otherwise incapacitated from serving as such executrix I nominate and appoint my daughter, Doris Waddell Hawkins, executrix and direct that she serve with the same powers and exemptions as would have my wife.

ITEM FIVE: I hereby give and grant to my said executrix full power and authority to sell any property owned by me at the time of my death, real or personal, at private or public sale, without order or permission of any Court.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the said John Wallace Waddell, have hereunto set my signature and seal on this the 23 day of August, 1956.
