AFFIDAVIT

Before me the undersigned authority, in and for the said County and State personally appeared the undersigned Affiant who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Cora Elizabeth Bell and I am 86 years of age, I am the widow of John H. Bell, who departed this life intestate on September 24, 1952, in Shelby County, Alabama, and at the time of his death owned the following described real property, lying situated and being in Shelby County, Alabama;

Commencing at the NW corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Two (2) Township Twenty two (22) Range four West, running South along said 40 acre line 420 feet to point of beginning; thence South Two hundred and ten feet (210), thence East Two hundred and ten (210), thence North Two hundred and ten feet (210), thence West Two hundred and ten (210), to point of beginning. Containing one acre in the Southwest quarter of Northwest Quarter of Section Two (2) Township Twenty Two South, Range four West, Situated in Shelby County, Alabama, reserving all the coal, iron ore and other minerals, under and upon said land, together with the usual mining rights and privileges; and subject to Timber Sale Contract between Southern Mineral Land Company and Burr Harris dated October 10, 1931 and expiring by its terms May 1, 1934.

My late husband acquired title to the hereinabove described real property by deed recorded in Deed Book 96, at Page 139, in the Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

At the time of his death on September 24, 1952, my late husband was a resident of Shelby County, Alabama, and his estate was solvent. The said John H. Bell had no previous marriages and had no children born of him during his lifetime and none adopted by him. At the time of the said John H. Bell's death, his mother and father were deceased, he being their only child and having no brothers and sisters.
