to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we,

(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto

Roger N. Wheeler and wife, Glenda R. Wheeler

(herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

Lots 13 and 14 in Block 2, of First Addition to Fall Acres Subdivision in Map Book 4, page 77, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, situated in and being a part of the S¹/₂ of the SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄ of Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject to restrictions as follows: "All lots for residential purposes only, and dwellings shall have a minimum of 1,000 square feet in the main body of the house. No structure of a temporary nature, such as trailers, tents, shacks, basements, garages, or other outbuildings shall be used as a residence either temporarily or permanently", and this covenant shall attach to and run with the land.
