RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED FOR PUBLIC ROAD

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned,

_____ and wife _____ of the County and State aforesaid, in and for the consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid by Shelby County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and for the further consideration of the benefit accruing to us and to the public from the construction or improvement of a public road through our lands, in Shelby County, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Shelby County, its successors or assigns, a Right-of-way hereinafter described, over and across our said lands in Shelby County, Alabama, for a public road; which right-of-way shall be

see below _____ feet in width on _____ side of the center line of said road, as it is now located and staked out by the Highway Department or as much of our lands as is required to make a see below _____ foot right-of-way across our lands, said right-of-way herein conveyed being more particular described as follows, to-wit: And as shown on the right-of-way map of Project NCP2-111 as recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County.

Commence at the southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T 22 S, R 2 W and run east along the south boundary line of said quarter quarter section a distance of 1272.0 feet to the point of beginning on the northwest 40' right of way line of Project CP2-111; thence continue east along said south boundary line a distance of 80 feet to the southeast corner of said quarter quarter section; thence run north along the east boundary line of said quarter quarter section a distance of 33 feet to a point on the northwest 40' right of way line of said project; thence run S 66°16'W along said northwest 40' right of way line a distance of 88 feet to the point of beginning.

Said parcel of land is lying in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T 22 S, R 2 W and contains 0.03 acres, more or less.
