Affiant further avers that he was born in Vincent, Alabama where Dr. Jones had lived and practiced medicine all of his adult life.

Affiant further avers that the said Dr. W. A. Jones was born in Vincent, Alabama.

Affiant further avers that Dr. Wade A. Jones' wife, Arberta Jones predeceased him; that Flora Jones was not the widow of Dr. Wade A. Jones, but was his mother.

Affiant further avers that Ada Jones, was the sister of Dr. Wade A. Jones; and that Etta R. Chamberlain was the sister of Dr. Wade A. Jones and Ada Jones.

Affiant further avers that Etta R. Chamberlain predeceased Ada Jones, having died intestate, leaving as her sole surviving heirs and next of kin, her sister, Ada Jones and brother, Dr. Wade A. Jones.

Affiant further avers that the property described in the Will of Dr. Wade A. Jones was his homestead, located approximately two miles east of Vincent.

Affiant further avers that he was one of the Executors of the Will of Dr. Wade A. Jones, deceased, and there has been a final settlement of his estate, and there are no outstanding debts of the estate.

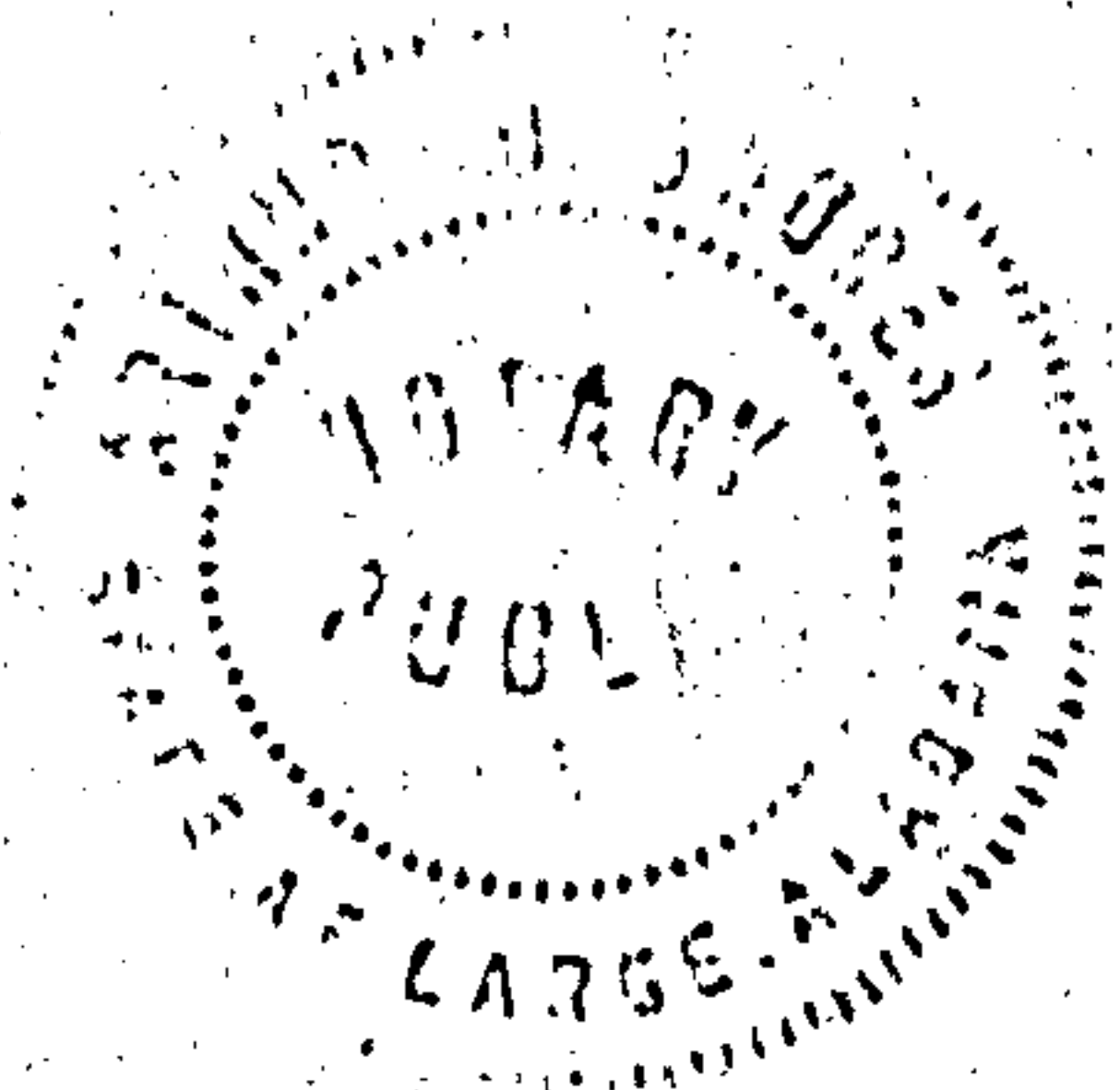
This affidavit is given to perfect title in property described as follows:
