Parkman, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 258 at page 742, Office of Judge of Probate Of Shelby County, Alabama, and we subsequently purchased another parcel, containing five acres, more or less, from said Lynn K. Parkman and wife, Genevieve S. Parkman, on May 23, 1970, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 262 at page 471 in said Probate Office.

The property description contained in said deed recorded in Deed Book 258 at page 742, and the property description contained in said deed recorded in Deed Book 262 at page 471, each refer to a certain unpaved road which runs in a Northerly direction from a paved "new County Highway", as a "County gravel road". Said road referred to as a "County gravel road" is not in fact a County road, and is not in fact a public road at all, it being a private road, not used by the public.

Said road referred to as a "County gravel road" is not maintained as a County road by Shelby County and has not been so maintained, so far as I know. I have recently contacted the Shelby County Engineer about this matter and have learned that Shelby County does not claim said road as a public road and have learned that Shelby County does in fact refuse to maintain said road or work on it in any manner.
