Keyes, Sr., a resident of said County and State, being of sound mind and disposing memory, and being aware of the uncertainties of this life do hereby make, publish, and declare this instrument as and for my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all wills and codicils thereto heretofore made by me. It is my will that this instrument bind afterborn and after adopted children.

ONE: I will that my executrix, hereinafter named, pay all my just debts as soon as practicable after my death.

TWO: BEQUEST OF ENTIRE ESTATE: I hereby give, devise, and bequeath my estate of which I die seized or possessed to my beloved wife, Helen O'Hare Keyes, to have and to hold absolutely and forever, including real, personal, and mixed property.

(a) In the event that my wife, Helen O'Hare Keyes, predeceases me, or we should die in a common disaster, I hereby give, devise and bequeath my entire estate to my beloved children, John J. Keyes, Jr. and Michael J. Keyes, and including after born and after adopted children, share and share alike.

THREE: I hereby nominate and appoint my wife, Helen O'Hare Keyes, as executrix of this my last will and testament. It is my will that she not post bond nor account to any court for her actions as such. In case of a common disaster, John J. Keyes, Jr. and Michael Keyes shall act as co-executors under the same conditions.
