Dear Mr. Head:

This acknowledges receipt of your letter of March 12, 1971 regarding parcels of tax property located in Shelby County.

I checked the records in this office and find that property described as the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 24, Range 12E sold to the State for taxes in 1931 in the name of James Smith. The records also indicate that all of this property was redeemed by Irene Smith on May 6, 1933. I am returning your application for cancellation, as the State no longer claims an interest in this property, as a result of this tax sale.

The records indicate that property described as the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 24, Range 12E sold in 1911 in the name of J. E. Dexter. There is a notation on our records that this sale was erroneous and has been cancelled by the State.
