The Affiant who after first being fully sworn deposes and states the following:

"I am 55 years of age and live across the highway from Lucille Clemonts, who is also known as "Lucille Clemons". I have known Lucille Clemonts and knew her husband, Mr. Turner Clemonts, who died in 1954. I know of my own knowledge that Mr. Turner Clements did not leave a will and the following are the heirs of Mr. Turner Clemonts: the widow, Lucille Clemonts, and the following children: John A., William, Carrie Lue, Ethel Mae, Turner, Jr., Robert and Willie Roy. These were the only heirs and there are no deceased heirs or children of deceased children.

"The above named heirs of Turner Clemonts spell their names "Clemons" and "Clements", but are children of Turner Clemonts and Lucille Clemonts.

"I further state that I am not related to the above named family, but I have known them for approximately 25 years.

"Turner Clements and his family entered into possession of the property described herein and other lands during the year 1900. He lived in a house on these lands, and maintained a garden and small live stock and claimed the property as his own until the time of his death. He assessed and paid taxes on subject property and other lands soon after he entered into possession up until the date of his death.

"Turner Clemonts held subject property and other lands considered as a home place openly, notoriously, continuously and adversely to all persons from // 5to the date of his death in 1954. His widow, Lucille Clemonts still lives on a portion of the property and it has been known for many years as the Turner and Lucille Clemonts "homeplace".

"The land belonging to the Clemonts family is properly described as follows:
