

Personally appeared before me, the undersigned authority, a Notary Public in and for said County and State, W. D. Upton, who being by me first duly sworn, on oath says as follows:

My name is W. D. Upton. I am over the age of 21 years and reside in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama. I am familiar with the following described land:

Begin at the SE corner of the NE% of the NW% of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 3 West; thence run southerly along the east boundary line of the SE% of the NW% of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 3 West for 230.0 feet; thence turn an angle of 121 degrees 17% to the right and run northwesterly 640 feet, more or less, to the center of Cahaba Valley Creek; thence run northeasterly up and along the center of said creek with the meanderings thereof for 412 feet, more or less, to a point that is 470.0 feet perpendicular from the south boundary line of the NE% of the NW% of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 3 West; thence run easterly parallel to the south boundary line of the NE% of the NW% of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, for 390.0 feet, more or less, to a point on the east boundary line of the NE% of NW% of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 3 West; thence run southerly along the east boundary line of said ½ ½ Section 470 feet to the point of beginning. Being a part of the SEL of the NWL and the NEL of NW% of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, and being 5.647 acres, more or less. EXCEPTED from the above described land the South 30 feet, which is a dedicated roadway.
