NOTE OF RECEIPT

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the North West quarter of Section two, in Township twenty, of range two East in the District of Nebraska and State of Nebraska containing Eighty acres and thirty seven and a half hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Eliza Stearns*

Now know ye, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Elizabeth Turner and her heirs* the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Elizabeth Turner and her heirs and assigns forever.*
